I wanted to cover some policies and procedures for our dock and ramp since boating and pool season is upon us. The first item is the use of handcarts to haul supplies out to the dock. Please remember to return the handcart back to the sail shed before you depart on your boat. Leaving the cart on the dock could end up in someone's way or it could get knocked into the water. Second, as waiting in line to drop your boat at the ramps is the perfect opportunity to prepare your boat for offloading. Waiting to do this will slow down the line, taking away time on the water. Third, the only temporary trailer parking available is next to the tennis court which is marked with signs that say temporary parking. Parking your trailer anywhere else at the club is prohibited.

The pool officially opens today so I wanted to cover some of the main points for everyone while going for a swim. There is no glass allowed inside the fenced-in area around the pool. If glass gets in the pool, it must be completely drained costing the club thousands of dollars. Secondly, guests are to pay the \$5 fee for use of the pool. There is a QR code attached to the fence that will allow you to pay by Venmo to make it easier for everyone to pay. Third, I have had some members ask me about swimming lessons this summer for children and grandchildren. Please email Kelly Lesesne, Club Services Manager, with your request at bysc.events@gmail.com and we will start to create a schedule. Lastly, we will need to close the pool area on occasion to address issues such as chemical imbalance, repairs, and weather. When the pool closed sign is up, members and guests are not allowed inside the fence around the pool per DHEC regulations. Please review all of the pool policies in section 4 of the BYSC Policy Manual located on our website under documents.

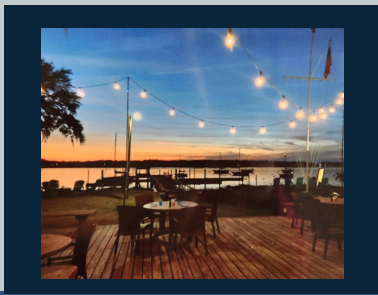
